Winemaker Dave Reilly is relentless in his pursuit of wines that are true to the character of the each varietal as well as to the soil from which they were born.

Grape

Sangiovese is one of the most widely planted grapes in Italy. Winemakers are able to use the grape as a bit of a blank canvas, with wines from the Sangiovese grape playing the full range from young, bright, strawberry inflected wines to brooding, leather and earth Brunellos suitable for cellaring for 20 or more years. Although 100% Italian in heritage, Sangiovese can be found in France, Australia, Argentina, California, and of course, Texas. Sangiovese's popularity is in part due to the pleasant acidity and mid range tannins that are characteristic of the fruit.

Food Pairings

Limestone Terrace Sangiovese pairs well with braised meats and hard cheeses.

Winemakers Notes

This wine is a blend of fruit exclusively from a vineyard just up the road. We were able to watch the fruit develop in 2011, so we knew well in advance that this would be a special wine. Deep dark cherry and great balance.
